Academy Facilitator: Dr. Joyce Burick Swarzman

Dr. Swarzman was the Head of School for Corbett Prep and the trainer/facilitator for the FCIS Academy since 1996. As of July 1, 2020, Dr. Swarzman now serves as the President of Training and Initiatives for Corbett Preparatory School of IDS. For fifteen years, Dr. Swarzman coordinated the award-winning USF Suncoast Area Teacher Training Honors Program (SCATTer), recognized, at the time, as one of the most innovative teacher training programs in the country. She also was the Associate Director of the David C. Anchin Center and the office of Clinical Education at the University of South Florida. She has been the recipient of the USF Senior Class Outstanding Professor of the Year Award, an Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching, and numerous honors from educational organizations. From 1989 through 1992, she directed the Collegium for the Advancement of Teaching for award-winning teachers. For eight years, she facilitated the Commissioner of Education's Round Table to honor the Florida Teachers of the Year and was a featured speaker at the National Teacher of the Year Conference. She began her career as a classroom teacher in Chicago, Atlanta, and New York.

Since completing her graduate work at Teachers College Columbia University, Dr. Swarzman has trained well over 18,000 teachers and educators. She continues to serve as a consultant and lecturer to school districts and numerous organizations in the United States, Spain, China, and Belize. Her work is documented in the book, "It's All About Kids: Every Child Deserves A Teacher of the Year", now translated in Spanish and Chinese. Dr. Swarzman designed the M.O.R.E. Model (Multiple Options for Results in Education) which was founded on leading research-based educational practices. Dr. Swarzman was an FCIS (Florida Council of Independent Schools) Board member from 2009-2014 and served as a Board member for FLAG (Florida Association for the Gifted) and currently as a Board member with Frameworks of Tampa Bay-for SEL-Social Emotional Learning.
