

SECONDARY/ RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL NURSE - Campus & Residential

This is a 10 month position; Housing is provided as this position requires living in our residential boarding community

Windermere Preparatory School is seeking an experienced Nurse to assist our Secondary School and Residential Life students with all school health policies and programs. The Nurse will provide expertise of school health services and will be responsible to care for the general medical needs and medical emergencies of our secondary and boarding students.

Using their clinical knowledge and judgment, the successful candidate will be performing the following duties:

- Respond to reports of pain or sickness as they arise and assess the student;
- Communicate with Residence Life Managers regarding boarding students medical follow up;
- Responsible for sorting and passing out medications accurately;
- Serve as a consultant/liaison with other school professionals, such as physical education teachers, coaches, and counselors in the absence of the lead nurse;
- Assist Lead nurse with developing and delivering health/sex-related curriculum and education to high school students;
- Assist with performing health screenings;
- Monitor immunizations & assist with validation of student medical requirements in files;
- Manage new/returning students/families in Magnus compliance;
- Assist with medication administration and health care procedures;
- Assist with managing students with chronic health conditions and disabilities
- Provide additional clinic coverage days as needed for field trips, drug testing, student travel, etc.
- Other duties as assigned

Job Requirements:

- Current FL RN license
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing required
- Current CPR and First Aid Certification
- 3+ years experience required, preferably in a school or pediatric setting
- Ability to live in Residential Housing
- Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license
- Ability to assess situations and act quickly
- Communicate appropriately, collaboratively, and effectively with students, parents, administrators, other school personnel, health care providers, and community agencies
- Demonstrate a genuine interest in the student population and its health needs.
- Be a self-starter or self-motivated
- Knowledge of Magnus preferred and proficiency with computers and various software applications.

This is a 10 month position and candidate must have ability to live in our Residential Village.
